A form of sexual abuse that occurs when a child or youth engages in sexual activity, usually through manipulation or coercion, in exchange for money, food, drugs, shelter or other considerations.

SEY provides sexually exploited youth voluntary, intensive crisis response and support services.

SEY PROGRAM is for youth:

- Aged 13 - 18
- Living or spending time in Surrey, White Rock, Cloverdale, Langley and Delta.
- Who are disconnected from mainstream services and/ or their families
- For whom sufficient information is available to support a belief that the youth is being sexually exploited.

The SEY Program is operated by Pacific Community Resources (PCRS)
